The **National Economics ChallengeSM** is a fun and free way for students to flex their intellectual muscle and test their economic knowledge. Competitions are held at the State, National Semi-Final, and National Final levels for high school students in two divisions: The Adam Smith Division, for advanced placement, international baccalaureate and honors students; and the David Ricardo Division for semester general economics students.

FALL 2015–SPRING 2016: ECONOMICS CHALLENGE COMPETITION BEGINS

Teachers may view rules and register teams of 4 high school students. No team limits so this makes a great class activity. Check with your local council for specific dates.

APRIL 19, 2016: STATE CHAMPIONS ANNOUNCED

State Champions are announced and are invited to participate in the National Semi-Final.

APRIL 26, 2016 (APRIL 21, 2016*): NATIONAL SEMI-FINAL

The State Champion will compete in the National Semi-Final.

MAY 20–23, 2016: NATIONAL FINALS

The top four teams in each division from the National Semi-Final will compete for the national title.
