The **National Economics Challenge**<sup>SM</sup> is a fun and free way for students to flex their intellectual muscle and test their knowledge of economics. Competitions are held at the State, National Semi-Final, and National Final levels for high school students in two divisions: the Adam Smith Division, for advanced placement, international baccalaureate and honors students; and the David Ricardo Division for semester general economics students.

#### FALL 2016-SPRING 2017: ECONOMICS CHALLENGE COMPETITION BEGINS

Teachers may view rules and register teams of four high school students. There are no team limits so this makes a great class activity. Check with your local council for specific dates.

### **APRIL 11, 2017: STATE CHAMPIONS ANNOUNCED**

The State Champions are announced and invited to participate in the National Semi-Finals.

### **APRIL 25, 2017 (APRIL 20, 2017\*): NATIONAL SEMI-FINALS**

The State Champion will compete in the National Semi-Finals.

\*Test date for schools that are on spring break on 4/25/17.

#### MAY 20–22, 2017: NATIONAL FINALS

The top four teams in each division from the National Semi-Finals will compete for the national title in New York City.
